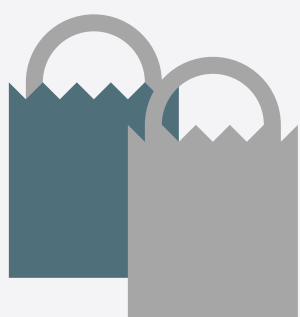


# MEASURES AGAINST THE CORONAVIRUS IN MECKLENBURG-WESTERN POMERANIA

## MOUTHGUARD DUTY FROM APRIL 27TH



From April 27, mouth and nose protection (mouthguard/mask, scarf or cloth) is mandatory in shops and in local public transport.



**Exceptions:** children up to school age and people who cannot wear a mouth and nose cover due to disabilities.

### SHOPPING

Retail sector is largely reopened. Construction and garden markets are also opened under certain conditions.

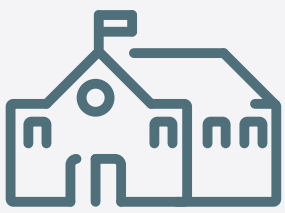


### LIBRARIES

Book loans are possible. The libraries can open again.

# MEASURES AGAINST THE CORONAVIRUS IN MECKLENBURG-WESTERN POMERANIA

## Relaxing of regulations as of April 20, 2020



### SCHOOL

Schools will gradually open from April 27th. Class 10 at regional schools, class 12 at regular high schools and comprehensive schools, class 13 at evening schools will make the start.



### DAYCARE

Nurseries, kindergartens, day care facilities and after-school care centres will initially remain closed. From April 27, emergency care will be gradually expanded to other professional groups.



### GASTRONOMY

The gastronomy in Mecklenburg-Western Pomerania remains closed. Delivery and pick-up services are possible.



### CULTURAL INSTITUTIONS

Cultural institutions such as cinemas, theatres, museums or galleries remain closed.



### ZOO

Zoos, animal and bird parks as well as botanical gardens can open their outdoor facilities again - without using restaurants and playgrounds.



### SPORTS

Sport is possible on sports fields and other outdoor facilities alone, in pairs and with the core family.
