

Leaflet for <u>people</u> returning from RISK AFFECTED AREAS valid until 31.01.2021

For travelers from a particular internationally risk-affected area (visit: https://www.rki.de/DE/Content/InfAZ/N/Neuartiges_Coronavirus/Risikogebiete_neu.html) there is a 10-day quarantine and the obligation to report to the responsible health authority. Please register on the website <u>www.einreiseanmeldung.de</u>. If it is not possible, please fill out the **"Meldeformular nach Einreise aus Risikogebieten"**, which you can find on our website <u>www.rostock.de/gesundheitsamt</u> and send it by email to <u>reiseverkehr@rostock.de</u>

According to the quarantine regulation of the state of Mecklenburg-Vorpommern, a successful first test after entry or not older than 48 hours upon entry does NOT lift the quarantine. But there are a few exceptions, see the quarantine regulation.

However, if there are no symptoms, the quarantine time can be shortened with a second test. This test can be carried out at the earliest 5 days after entry. Requirements to the test are: www.rki.de/covid-19-tests. Please send the negative test result and the informal request for shortening to reiseverkehr@rostock.de.

- > 10 days quarantine after entry from a risk area
- > The initial test on entry does not lift the quarantine.
- The quarantine time can be shortened with a second test. This test can be carried out at the earliest 5 days after entry. Please send the negative test result and the informal request for shortening to reiseverkehr@rostock.de
- > The public health authority does not carry out any tests.
